GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES



1. **Originality:** The text must contain only unpublished results of the author's own research.
2. **Length:** The article should be at least 6 pages (10,000 characters), excluding the abstract and bibliography.
3. **Structure of the article (IMRAD):**
 - Introduction
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
4. **Plagiarism Check:** The originality of the text must be at least 75%. A plagiarism certificate must be provided.
5. **Peer Review:** All articles undergo peer review.
6. **Content Composition:**
 - The title must accurately reflect the content of the article.
 - Author Information: Last name, first name, patronymic, academic degree, position, place of work, contact phone number, email, ORCID code.
 - Abstract (250-300 words): Reflects the content of the article, conclusions, methodology, and scientific contribution.
 - Keywords (5-10 words/phrases).
 - UDC code (use the website: <https://teacode.com/online/udc/>).
7. **LanguageS:** Metadata, abstract, and keywords must be provided in Uzbek, Russian, and English.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS



1. **Format:** Word, Times New Roman font, 14pt size, 1.15 line spacing, 2 cm margins. Pages should be numbered.
Formatting: Bold or italic font. Do not use borders.
References: In-text citations in APA style (e.g., Sobirov, 2020; Vokhidov & Sarvarov, 2018).
Tables and Diagrams:
Tables should be created using Word table cells.
Diagrams and graphs: in EXCEL format or vector format (*.pdf, *.eps, *.ai).
Formulas: MathType editor.

Bibliography:

A minimum of 10 sources, including 2 from Scopus or WoS.

Examples:

Book: Abdulkarimov B.A. (2010). Title of the book. Tashkent: Iqtisodiyot.

Article: Harris et al. (2021). Title of the article. Journal, 10(2), 45-50. <https://doi.org/xxxx>

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ABSTRACT



1. **Expanded (250-300 words), informative, structured.**

The abstract should briefly reflect the main content, research results, and conclusions. It should be concise, without unnecessary repetition or general information.

2. **Additional requirements:**

Errors and typos: Carefully proofread the text. Careless formatting may lead to the rejection of the article.

Formatting:

Do not use forced line breaks or empty lines to separate paragraphs.

Do not apply macros or automatic commands.
